#### Berni Jeavons Ukrainian Appeal

Berni Jeavons was in touch to update re the Ukrainian family of 3 ladies and one small child of whom parishioners have been supportive over the last year. They desperately need suitable and affordable rental accommodation by the end of March. Berni asks that anyone who knows of rental accommodation or has links to providers, please contact her at the Vigil Mass or via Fr Gerald or the Parish Office. Also, Berni has appealed for help with materials for Dr Tatyana and a Ukrainian battalion she is supporting. They need woollen blankets, warm socks (unwanted Christmas presents are welcomed), thermal underwear, Paracetamol and Ibuprofen. You can leave any donations for Berni on the table at the back of the Church.


NB There is a First Aid box in the Church Sacristy should anyone need it at any time.
