
Cost of living crisis:

Pro-Life Amendment Update

"Initially, it looked like the Report Stage of the Criminal Justice Bill and a vote on Caroline Ansell's 22-week amendment was going to happen before Easter, but now the Government has confirmed that this is not the case. It will be happening after Easter, likely in late April. Thanks to you and your parishioners, we recently delivered a petition with 102,573 signatures to the Prime Minister at number 10! This is one of the largest petitions to be delivered to the Prime Minister over the last year and demonstrates the overwhelming support for this important pro-life change to the law. There is still time to collect a postcard today from the back of the church and to post it to your MP in support of the 22-week amendment.
